








#### PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE



The John R. Wooden Award steering committee honored Bill Shumard, President/CEO of SOSC as the inaugural recipient of the Tommy Hawkins Game-Changer Award. Congrats Bill! The Wooden Award has had a long-standing relationship with SOSC, hosting an annual basketball tournament. The Wooden Award/SOSC one-day tournament features the Wooden Award All-American's and their coaches assisting SOSC teams selected to play in the event on the Wooden Award Court at the Los Angeles Athletic Club (LAAC). #WeAreSOSC #WoodenAward



SOLA members enjoyed fellowshipping with and hearing Bill Shumard give an update on the latest with Special Olympics Southern California. He was excited that our local softball team, Lakewood Dirt Bags, with the veteran Global Messenger Dustin Plunkett on the team, will be playing in the **2018 Special Olympics USA Games**, in Seattle, Washington on July 1-6.

Bill spoke about some of the new competitions being introduced this spring: Flag Football and Cheer Leading and moving Bowling to become a summer sport.

Over the past 10 years Special Olympics Southern California has grown from about 8,000 athletes with an average age of 37 to over 35,000 athletes, average age of 16, thanks to the inclusion of Unified Sports on school campuses. Bill honored our SOLA member Dean Crowley, past CIF Commissioner, who met with him and others several years ago to spearhead Unified Sports in our public schools. Last fall, Unified Sports is now in 400 California high schools. California is the 7<sup>th</sup> state to give Special Olympics athletes Varsity Letters so they can purchase Letterman's Jackets. Now intellectually challenged athletes can proudly wear school shirts, hats, and Letterman's Jackets. What a transformation there now is of changing cultural attitudes on campuses for inclusion, diversity, anti-bullying and acceptance.

Bill Shumard spoke of "passing the torch" to new leadership at Special Olympics Southern California, but with the advice of the past senior leaders giving them counsel and stability. New programs and ideas are being "piloted" in SOSC before taking them nationally.

This year in July will be the 50<sup>th</sup> Anniversary celebration of Special Olympics in Chicago. Other highlights mentioned: the 2018 book by Eileen McNamara, <u>Eunice: The Kennedy That</u> <u>Changed the World</u> about Eunice Kennedy Shriver, who started Special Olympics; ESPN now is the worldwide sponsor of Unified Sports; and Kaiser Permanente signed a 3 year contract as a Special Olympics Major Sponsor. Kaiser Permanente will serve as its Official Health Partner for the 2018 Special Olympics USA Games in Seattle.

## Guest Presentation at SOLA Meeting: "Football for Life"



Taking the life lessons learned on the football field to the **Pine Ridge Indian Reservation**! Coach Joe Pina and his wife received a glimpse into life on the reservation in 2015 when they travelled in South Dakota. They learned that officials of the Pine Ridge Indian reservation had declared a State of Emergency due to a rash of teen suicides (the youngest being 9 year of age). The odds are stacked against the youth of this South Dakota reservation, which borders Nebraska.

Did you know that on the Pine Ridge Reservation: 97% of the population lives far below the U.S. federal poverty line; High School dropout rate is 70%; Unemployment rate is upwards of 90% due to lack of industry, technology or commercial infrastructure on the reservation; and, the list of obstacles placed in front of the youth on Pine Ridge goes on and on....

The **Football for Life** group is comprised of former and current coaches and players who believe the game of football was instrumental to the success they have achieved in life. The founders and directors of *Football for Life* know from personal experience the vital impact of youth sports participation.

My husband and I are excited to be making our second trip to the Pine Ridge Indian Reservation this coming summer. In collaboration with Head Coach **Sam Bravo** of Pine Ridge High School we are tailoring a program to the best benefit of the **Pine Ridge H.S. Thorpes football team.** When first presented with the idea by **Football** for Life, founder Joseph Pina, Coach Bravo stated: "This has been exactly what I have been looking for to give us the competitive edge we need!"

In 2017, our first year, the program included a 2-day coaching clinic with Coach Bravo's staff, followed by 3 days of "on the field" lessons with the Pine Ridge football players. Our Football for Life volunteers fed all players and coaches daily. Utilizing technology, we were able to follow the Thorpes progress throughout the season. We utilized this to make suggestions and adjustments each week to assist in the advancement of the team's strategy for each opponent. The 2017 season was a resounding success! The Thorpes football team finished 7:3 and were The Black Hills Conference Champions!! We are looking forward to add to that success in 2018.

Friday, April 6, 2018 we hosted our 1<sup>st</sup> Football for Life Golf Tournament at San Juan Hills Golf Club. It was a

success and all funds raised will be directly impacting the Thorpes football program. It is our intention to get the players new uniforms (since last season they were not matching) and other needed equipment. We also hope to expand our campaign and make a monetary donation to the Girl's Athletic program at Pine Ridge High School.

Currently we are also preparing to create a pilot program; the **first Native American Family Host program.** It is in the beginning stages and is being modeled after the *Foreign Exchange Student* program. The goal is to mentor all students who wish to pursue a College Education.

Our long-term goal for *Football for Life* is to reach all three High School on the reservation, positively impacting the young men and women of the Pine Ridge Indian Reservation.




